Abstracts will be accepted into one of three categories:

Clinical Vignettes - cases that illustrate a rare disease, or an unusual or interesting clinical presentation of an established disease entity

Research – clinical and/or lab research, delineating a new investigation into mechanisms of disease or a detailed review of a clinical problem

Innovation – area quality improvement, safety projects or other areas of innovation in healthcare.

Submission Information The deadline for abstract submission is 11:59 p.m. PST on Thursday, September 10, 2020. If your abstract is chosen, you will be invited to present a poster at the virtual competition on October 10, 2020. You will receive an email within two weeks after the submission deadline indicating whether your abstract has been accepted into the poster competition. - Specifications: A maximum of one abstract per first author may be submitted. The abstract word limit is 450 words.
- No edits are allowed once the abstracts are submitted. Please ensure that all errors are corrected before submitting. It is highly recommended that a faculty mentor at your institution reviews the abstract prior to submission.
- If the abstract is accepted, you must submit a poster saved as PPT file for the competition. Poster criteria will be available on the abstract acceptance letter. If the first author is not available to present the poster, then the second author can do so.
